

Our Intensive Care Unit (ICU) is manned around the clock by specially trained, critical care consultants, dedicated nurses and technicians. It comprises of 10 beds that are equipped with the latest technology, with the intention to take care of the patients and provide quick intensive medical treatment.

- RMC's team of experienced critical care professionals is supported by the entire range of super-speciality services. The unit includes trauma and cardiac teams, re-constructive and rehabilitative technicians and nurses whose primary aim is to deliver the shortest turn-around times for diagnosis and treatment of trauma patients. Following are the facilities offered in the ICU at RMC:
- 10-bed ICU equipped with the latest



technology and cardiac monitors

- Specially trained ICU nurses care for no more than two patients at a time
- ICU doctors are trained specialists in critical care treatment
- A dedicated 'emergencies only' Operation Theatre
- An isolation room for management and care of infectious patients



Gynaecology and Obstetrics

Our Gynaecology and Obstetrics Department has dedicated birthing suites to provide a safe and secured environment for the new born and the mother. The quality treatment offered in this department over the years makes RMC as one of the best in Tanzania for Gynaecology and Obstetrics treatment.



With high level training in surgical practices as well as extensive experience from reputed institutions, RMC consultants are committed to providing ethical and evidence based surgical options to all of our patients. The department also conducts various surgical camps, inviting surgeons from specialised institutions in Indian and other countries.

Laparoscopic Surgery

Regency Medical Centre is the first hospital in Tanzania to provide laparoscopic surgery. This procedure makes it possible for surgeons to reach various organs in the body cavities through small cuts ensuring cosmetic results, early recovery and early return to normal life.

Our advanced laparoscopic equipment was donated by Dar es Salaam-born consultant gynaecologist and laparoscopic surgeon Dr. Mahendra Thakrar. These high definition instruments enabled RMC to provide a wide range of open, keyhole or minimally invasive procedures for diagnosis and treatment of various disorders.

• Laparoscopic surgery has become the preferred method for performing many

general surgery procedures. Laparoscopic surgery is also referred to as minimally invasive surgery, band aid surgery, or keyhole surgery

- Abdominal and pelvic problems are diagnosed and treated quickly and efficiently
- Post-operative discomfort is lowered and patients experience quicker recovery times
- Comprehensive treatment and microsurgical procedures available for:
 - Abdominal organs (gallbladder, appendix, spleen and intestines)
 - Various types of hernias (inguinal, femoral, umbilical, incisional and hiatus, etc.)
 - > Emergency trauma management
 - Salivary, thyroid and adrenal glands, breast, undescended testis, hydrocele, varicocele, varicose veins and anorectal disorders



Dialysis Centre

In the last decade, RMC has performed over 40,000 dialysis procedures and has given access to advanced treatment to countless patients at subsidised rates. RMC has facilitated kidney transplants for more than hundred end-stage kidney failure patients in the past and is committed to do so in the future.

RMC's Dialysis Team understands the impact of chronic kidney failure has on people's lives. They are focused on the alleviation of kidney patients' suffering through the provision of quality consultation, treatment and dialysis using the latest equipment and techniques.




Chronic Disease Clinic Diabetes · Hypertension · Stroke

RMC provides a far-reaching approach to prevention and management of chronic diseases like Diabetes, Hypertension and Stroke, by adhering to international standards of practices. Through this clinic, RMC aims to maximize care coordination and patient selfmanagement.

Chronic disease is a major cause of hospitalisation if not addressed with adequate prevention and management strategies. Under the guidance of diabetologists, endocrinologists, dieticians, physiotherapists, ophthalmologists, nephrologists and bariatric surgeons, RMC provides a coordinated care programme for patients suffering from chronic diseases.

· Comprehensive screening, management and





prevention of complications in diabetes

- Weight loss assistance programmes, essential for management of diabetes
- Extensive care for patients suffering from high-blood pressure to prevent the risk of cardiovascular disease and stroke

Orthopaedics

This department offers specialized care in the field of complex trauma, polytrauma and related sub-specialities. RMC conducts regular orthopaedic consultation camps in association with reputed. These camps have reduced the number of international referrals, thus cutting costs in treatments.

RMC offers dedicated services for trauma and general orthopaedics, spine surgery, sports medicine and joint reconstruction including minimally invasive surgery for total knee and hip replacements, hip resurfacing, unicondylar (partial) knee replacement as well as shoulder and elbow replacements. From accurate diagnosis, to development of a personalized treatment plan and thorough post-operative follow-up, we work hard to ensure you have



the best possible outcome.

- Joint replacement and arthroscopic surgery provides accuracy and superior long-term results
- Physiotherapy and rehabilitation support programmes return patients home faster and with greater independence
- Less invasive (minimal access and endoscopic) spine surgery procedures reduces recovery times



Physiotherapy

Our Physiotherapy department aims to restore movement and function to as near normal as possible after a patient has been affected by injury, illness or disability. Physiotherapy is provided in an inpatient and outpatient setting providing acute to preventative care, guided by a senior physiotherapist.

We offer specialist assessment and treatment, work with patients to improve their own health and well-being. Physiotherapy treatment works across, and in conjunction with, all disciplines of modern medicine from orthopaedics to oncology, neonatology to general surgery, rheumatology and sports medicine.

- Treatment of comprehensive musculoskeletal conditions and sport injuries
- Neuro physiotherapy and rehabilitation for patients suffering from a stroke, Parkinson disease or spinal cord injuries

Cancer Care/ Chemotherapy

The department runs a comprehensive cancer care programme that follows trans-disciplinary and multi-modality approaches in the field of adult and paediatric oncology. We believe in treating Cancer with a combination of Chemotherapy, Radiation Therapy, Surgery and Targeted Therapy.

Specialists in the field of medical oncology, haematology, radiation oncology, specialised surgery and bone marrow transplants work together to prevent, diagnose and treat cancer while providing high levels of patient care. RMC exploits this multi-disciplined teamwork through specialised clinics and an extensive range of oncology support services.

Lancet Laboratories

RMC has partnered with a fully-fledged, ultramodern Lancet Laboratories to offer over 3800 routine, specialised and esoteric tests from malaria to molecular diagnostics at affordable costs. These services are offered round-the-clock, 7days-a-week 24-hours a day with international expertise.

All Lancet laboratories are linked through a dedicated citpoerbfiand wireless network that allows their pathologists to access, monitor, supervise and electronically sign out all reports in all their laboratories, thus ensuring that international expertise is injected in every result.

ENT Unit

RMC provides inpatient and outpatient treatment, as well as emergency clinics for symptoms affecting the Ear, Nose or Throat. It combines the finest technology and adept manpower for correcting various kinds of voice disorders and performs advanced procedures.

Our ENT department provides comprehensive and specialised care covering both medical and surgical conditions related not just to the ear, nose and throat, but also to other areas in the head and neck region.

- All aspects of ENT are dealt with, from minor procedures and emergency services to major complex head and neck surgery for patients with cancer
- Ear and sinus infections, tonsillectomy,



nosebleeds, sleep apnoea, vertigo, heartburn and acid reflux

- Diagnostic testing and treatment for swallowing problems, communication impairments and cognitive impairments
- Elective and emergency services for ENT surgery and specialised treatment of all conditions in adults and children, including problems in hearing, deafness, tinnitus, cancers of the ENT are treated



Dental Clinic

Our Dental Clinic provides both conservative and restorative dentistry with a broad range of specialised treatments. With some of the best equipment on hand and a highly experienced staff of doctors and nurses, we care about giving only the highest standards of service.

RMC is committed to helping patients maintain and protect their teeth and gums, conserving the original teeth wherever possible to a state of normal function, health, and aesthetics. All procedures are performed with the utmost care under aseptic precautions to protect every patient from infection. The hospital's dental department has 2 full-time doctors and is amply staffed with nurses and caregivers.

Our restorative dentistry specialities include:

- Endodontics diagnosing and preventing diseases of the tooth pulp and tissues surrounding the root
- Periodontics disorders of the gums and supporting structures
- Prosthodontics reconstruction and replacement of teeth
- Pedodontics targeting conditions affecting dental development in children including fillings, extractions and preventative treatments
- Oral facial pain management arising from pain associated with a malignancy, or syndromes such as TMJ disorder, neuropathic pains or headaches
- Oral Pathology and oral medicine treating diseases of the mouth, jaws and related structures.



Ophthalmology


Our Ophthalmology department has state-of-the-art equipments to deal with the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of diseases of the eye and visual system, along with microsurgery. There are a number of checkups and procedures that are essential to make sure your eyes are healthy, we provide them all.

RMC treats all kinds of eye-related problems ranging from routine eye examination to other clinical conditions of the eye and surrounding structures. Many eye diseases can be treated successfully if caught early, and can be managed effectively with existing treatments and medicines.

Our specialist consultant dermatologists treat all forms of disfigurements, right from skin cancers and melanoma, to acne and skin related problems including allergies and inflammations. We provide a full service for the assessment, diagnosis and management of all skin conditions and diseases in a quality clinical environment. Our team has outstanding diagnostic skills and the ability to deliver effective treatment for full recoveries.

Diagnostics and Radiology

Diagnostics and Radiology department comprises highly skilled technicians and radiologists, dedicated to provide services round the clock. This includes contribution to emergency services, highly regarded interventional radiology and a comprehensive crosssectional imaging service.

Our technologically advanced medical equipment enables us to diagnose disease, plan treatment or find out how well treatment is working.

- Philips SD 800 Ultrasound unit for sonography and echocardiography
- Ultrasound for visceral organs

Our senior radiologists and qualified technicians deliver tests and screenings, quickly and effectively. A broad range of radiological services related to MRI, CT, Ultrasound, Fluoroscopy, Mammography and X-Ray are available to RMC patients. Routine radio-diagnostic techniques like IVP, Barium meal, HSG, contrast studies are also conducted.



Preventative Health Check-ups

RMC pioneered the concept of preventative and corporate health checks in Tanzania. Our preventive health package has helped prevent and treat various non-communicable diseases such as cardio-vascular disease, hypertension, stroke, cancer, diabetes and renal diseases.

Our extensive range of preventative health check-ups provide a full medical consultation with a physician that covers a detailed history, lifestyle profile, physical evaluations and review of laboratory investigations. Our health assessments offer a chance to stop and take stock of your well being. They give you a picture of where your health is at currently. In addition to giving a picture of current health they look at future health risks and how an individual can make lifestyle changes to become healthier in the short and long term.

- Electrocardiography test (ECGs) are reported within minutes by specialist cardiologists from Narayana Hrudayalaya Heart Institute in Bangalore (first in the country)
- Pulmonary function tests (PFTs) use hightech computerised equipment Spirometer (SPIROLAB) Endoscopy and Sigmoidoscopy using Olympus GI equipment
- Uroflowmetry tests evaluate any obstruction in the urine flow for patients with prostate enlargement, urethral strictures, etc. (first in the country)



RMC'S Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities — March

Improved access to primary care and affordable state-of-the-art secondary care treatment. RMC treats not only the common causes of illness and death (e.g. neonatal, childhood and maternal morbidity and mortality from malaria, TB, diarrhoea and HIV/AIDS); but also helps prevent and treat non-communicable diseases such as cardiovascular disease, hypertension, stroke, cancer, diabetes and renal disease. This is achieved through early detection of diseases and timely life-saving treatments at home in Tanzania as well as referrals abroad through our Preventive Executive Health Check-ups. Supply of special discounts to financially constrained patients especially when they are unable to pay for dialysis, CT scans, expensive laboratory tests and unforeseen bills as a result of prolonged hospital stays resulting from health complications. Special subsidised rates are given to NHIF and CCBRT patients, including children with Cancer, Hydrocephalus and Spina Bifida.

Regency Medical Centre sponsored the medical treatment of 120 vulnerable orphans for the entire year through NHIF Afya Bora card.









Facilitation of free and subsidised Eye Camps, Diabetic Camps and Screening and Diagnostic Camps by reputed hospitals in India. Treatments also included hip and joint replacements, spinal problems, neuro surgical problems and oncology, all within Tanzania. Not only did this enable better diagnosis and expert treatment but more importantly provided timely advice to financially constrained patients. Our local doctors and paramedics benefited from training through continuous medical education and hands on experience in the ever-changing field of medicine. **Provision of more than 40,000 subsidised dialysis sessions** to hundreds of patients over the last decade. Some patients were unable to pay even 50% of the costs, and in life-threatening emergencies, treatment was provided free of charge. More than 100 end stage kidney failure patients received kidney transplants, adding years to their lives.

Treatment of more than 3,000 children by RMC in partnership with the Lions Clubs of Dar es Salaam (HOST), Ministries of Health of Mainland and Zanzibar, Rodney Mutie Mengi Foundation and many other contributing partners. This has saved limited forex in country through subsidised rates of treatment.




